

SEESA DONOR RECOGNITION STRUCTURE

FUNDAMENTALS

1. Donors names will be published if permission has been given, in writing.
When permission is not authorized, the donor will be categorized as 'anonymous'.
2. Donations "in kind" may be receipted with proof of value (3 quotes) provided by the donor.
3. The Board embraces fundraising as a core role and responsibility of the Board, with Board members making an annual donation to the organization that is personally significant.
4. A "Book of Giving" will be published on the website annually, listing donors alphabetically within the recognition structure.

WHAT DOES MY DONATION SUPPORT?

Donations support the delivery of SEESA's core mission including salaries and benefits, facility improvements, equipment maintenance & replacement, music licensing fees, insurance, heat, light, office consumables, computers, technology, tools, art supplies, membership and program growth, and cafeteria services.

Advocate (\$100 - \$249)

Guardian (\$250 - \$499)

- All of “**Advocate**” plus
- A “thank you” telephone call from the Board President
- Donor name and category published on a large size professional poster for the SEESA Annual General Meeting

Leader (\$500 - \$999)

- All of “**Guardian**” plus
- Annual poster, as above, placed in the SEESA main reception area

Builder (\$1,000 - \$2,499)

- All of “**Leader**” plus
- An opportunity to speak at SEESA donor recognition and fundraising events

Benefactor (\$2,500 - \$4,999)

- All of “**Builder**” plus
- An invitation to tea with the SEESA Board President
- An opportunity to speak at major SEESA events

Patron \$5,000 - \$9,999

- All of “**Builder**” plus
- An Invitation to lunch with the SEESA Board of Directors
- Donor name and category highlighted in the SEESA Annual Report
- Donor name and category placed in a special section of the “Book of Giving” on the SEESA “donor” website page
- A SEESA room naming opportunity

Visionary (\$10,000 +)

- All of “**Builder**” plus
- An invitation to lunch with the SEESA Board of Directors and other donors in the “Leader” and “Patron” categories
- Donor name and category highlighted in the SEESA Annual Report
- Donor name and category placed in a special section of the “Book of Giving” on the SEESA “donor” website page
