

We gratefully acknowledge that the land on which our facility rests is Treaty 6 Territory and traditional lands of First Nations and Métis people. This meeting ground for many indigenous peoples includes nêhiyaw (Nay-hee-yow) also known as Cree including the Papaschase, Dene (Deh-neyh), Anishinaabe (Ah-nish-in-ah-bay), Nakota Isga (Na-koh-tah ee-ska)/Nakota Sioux (Na-koh-tah sue), and Niitsitapi (Nit-si-tahp-ee) also known as Blackfoot peoples. We also acknowledge this as a Métis' homeland which is also our city ward name, and now home of one of the largest communities of Inuit south of the 60th parallel. Their spiritual and practical relationships with the land continue to create a rich heritage for our community. We are honoured to share this land.
