Announcement

I am pleased to announce that Graham Witten has been seconded as Community Engagement Coordinator, at SEESA, for a 14-month term, effective May 1, 2026, ending June 30, 2027. This position has been made possible through a Project Grant from the Government of Alberta, along with additional funding from the City of Edmonton through the SCIP Grant. This new role is aligned with SEESA's Vision, Mission, and Values, and supports our commitment to addressing all components of the Six Determinants of Healthy Aging, as required through our funding as a large seniors-serving organization. The position will further strengthen the continued growth of our community outreach and engagement initiatives.

As a result of Graham's appointment, the organization will initiate a recruitment process for a Volunteer and Events Coordinator for a 14-month contract ending June 2027. Partial funding for this position has been secured through the Summer Jobs Grant.
