Free, Mobile Drop-Off Tax Clinic

March 11, 11:00am – 12:30pm and April 2, 11:00am – 12:30pm

Location: At SEESA in the Edmonton Room

Sign up begins on Tuesday, February 20

How it works:

- Only open to those age 55+ with a modest income (approx. \$35,000 individually or \$45,000 as a couple) and a simple tax situation (e.g. not self-employed, no investment over \$1000, no rental income, etc.)
- Call or visit the SEESA Front Desk to sign up for a drop-off date (limited capacity). Sign up begins on Tuesday, February 20.
- Pick up the required personal information forms from the SEESA front desk and complete on your own time.
- Bring completed forms and your tax slips to the Edmonton Room during your scheduled drop-off time for Strathcona Place Society (SPS) to collect.
- Your taxes will be filed electronically by SPS within approximately two
 weeks. Taxes will <u>not</u> be filed on site at SEESA during the clinic. You can
 expect a Notice of Assessment from the CRA within 10 business days.
- SPS will bring your tax return to SEESA when completed. It will be securely stored, and we will contact you to let you know it is available for pickup.
- SEESA does not provide direct support with filing your taxes or other information related to your taxes.
- You can contact SPS if you have any tax related questions by email, at finance@strathconaplace.com, or indicate your questions on your personal information form during your drop-off.
